Delete Appendix E as it exists entirely and replace it with the following:

**Appendix E**  
**TOWN OF BELLINGHAM**  
**CRPCD SEWER CAPACITY ALLOCATION PROCEDURE**  
**2002**

- A. Applicants seeking to receive CRPCD Sewer Capacity must complete the "CRPCD Emergency Sewer Capacity Allocation Application" form. (Attached)
- B. All parties that submitted requests for capacity after September of 1998 shall be removed from the "CRPCD Request for Capacity Summary List" (3/1/2002 List Attached) and must reapply if they seek capacity.
- C. In accordance with the past policy, those who have been allocated capacity will retain their rights to the capacity as long as approved time extensions are in place.
- D. CRPCD Emergency Sewer Capacity Allocation Application will be reviewed on a quarterly basis by the DPW Director who will submit recommendations to the Board of Selectmen. Recommendation shall include consideration of Sewer Need and Hardship of Applicants and Available Capacity from sewer meter readings and estimates.
- E. The Selectmen may vote to allocate capacity to property owners if they see fit.
- F. All properties granted CRPCD capacity by the Selectmen must connect to the sewer within six months of the date of the Selectmen's vote. Extensions can be granted upon majority vote of the Board of Selectmen.
- G. Applicants that are allocated CRPCD capacity are in no way released of any State or Bellingham regulation or requirement applicable to connecting to the public sewer.
