NEW RECYCLING SCHEDULE

(PLEASE REFER TO COLOR CODED CALENDAR - Match Street Letter Code on Calendar)

WHERE to recycle:

On your recycling day just put your filled bin out with your regular solid waste by 7:00 a.m. Rain or shine. AW will pick up your recyclable materials. Recyclables and solid waste will be collected by separate trucks.

NOTE: If you've accidentally discarded something that cannot be recycled, we'll leave it in your bin with a note to let you know why it was not recyclable.







WHEN to recycle:

Your recycling day will be your regular solid waste day every other week. Check the calendar attached for your scheduled weeks. Just remember to put your filled bin out with your regular solid waste by 7:00 a.m. It's that easy! Whenever a scheduled collection day falls on a holiday, that day's collection and the remainder of the week will be delayed one day.

◆ **Scheduled weekly curbside solid waste**

- Bulky waste/large items (Limit one per week) Mattresses, sofas, etc...
- **White goods collection: Call DPW @ 508-966-5816 for a scheduled collection date.**
- Limit: (5) 32 gallon containers & not to exceed 50 lbs. in weight
- Containers larger than 32 gallons will not be emptied
- Awkward items, such as rugs, non-metal playground equipment, etc. must be cut into 4 ft. lengths tied or bundled at curb. Each bundle is considered as one container.
- NO Hazardous materials or paints collected with curbside waste.
- Residents are required to contract with a private hauler for large clean outs over 5 bags.

- All curbside recycling materials accepted
- 20 lb. propane tanks must be empty
- Tires without rims

- Book Recycling - See container marked "Got Books?"
- White goods or appliances accepted
- Dead car batteries
- Mercury collected at recycle center
- NO hazardous waste
- NO motor oil
