

## Did you know...

- We routinely sample the drinking water to ensure all DEP drinking water standards are met. *Certified laboratories analyze sample contents and report the results to us.*
- Drinking water is supplied from well sources, which pass through our treatment facilities. *This ensures regulated contaminants are properly monitored, as well as proper disinfection.*
- A minimum of 40 system samples are collected each month for the presence of bacteria. *Additional samples are obtained from our raw water wells and treatment facilities.*
- Further sampling includes PFAS, Lead & Copper, and DBPs for safe drinking water. *Monthly & quarterly sampling frequency varies depending on regulatory requirements.*
- We continually improve water infrastructure to remain current with changing regulations. *Safe drinking water quality and affordability remain a priority for the Town and its residents.*
