

## Adams, Bosworth, Darling, Moore, Partridge Murders

Adams:

- June 26, 1832: Agreement between Samuel Adams, Stephen Coombs, Elijah Dewing Jr. – Coombs with Comfort Walker
- Assorted Dates: pay stub, grocery receipt; relating to Adams
- Amos Adams: receipt for post office box
- Annie T Adams and Amos [J] Adams letterhead(?)
- Random notes from the Amos Adams Diary courtesy of the Moore Family
- 1880 report: report of a murder, Amos Adams, and Frank Coombs
- Notes from Amos Adams
  - o 1905 assorted notes: commentary on work and payment, temperature, deaths, daily activities, misc. notes on money
  - o 1906 assorted notes: commentary on deaths, temperature, daily activities, marriages. July 28 note on money and wages, marks done over pencil with blue ink (could have been done much later, no way to tell)
  - o 1908 assorted notes: commentary on work, births, visits from a Dr. Gallison
  - o 1909 assorted notes: commentary on temperature, birth days, marriages, deaths, work, concerts at town hall, work and wages, misc. spendings
  - o Recipe for washing fluid
  - o 1911 assorted notes: commentary on work at the mill, purchases, temperature, anniversaries, weather
  - o 1915 assorted notes: commentary on weather, concerts, work, purchases
  - o 1917 assorted notes: attached to 1915 notes, from November to December, commentary on travels and church
  - o 1919 assorted notes: commentary on purchases, deaths, daylight savings, celebrations in Boston, travels, temperature, Adams' birthday, work
  - o 1920 assorted notes: commentary on deaths, purchases, dental procedures

Thayer

- Purchase of Bellingham land in June 1871 for four hundred and fifty dollars by Charles Thayer

Spencer
