

Bulk Item Pickup

Trash customers are allowed one bulk item per week. Place the bulk item next to the trash tote on the day of your scheduled pickup. Heavy items will be left behind; the resident is responsible for breaking it down to manageable pieces for disposal. Do not place item at curb if raining or snowing. If the item becomes water laden, it will not be picked up, and responsibility for disposal will be on the resident. Objects that are not picked up should be removed from the curb, out of the public travel way, by the end of the day.

Bulk items include:

Garden Hose (hose only - curl and bind, no plastic dispenser)

Porcelain tubs, sinks, toilets (separate toilet tank from bowl and place both items out) Small wooden furniture – Desk, tables, chairs, nightstands, etc.

Large wooden furniture – Bureau, entertainment stand, etc. (must be broken down) Carpet – Must be cut & rolled into 3' rolls, no more than 45 lbs. (can put out 3 rolls a week) Sofa – Couch, loveseat or chair – One per week (if a sleeper sofa, the metal frame must be removed from the sleep sofa).

The frame can either be brought to the Town Recycling Center or call E.L. Harvey for a Metal Goods pickup

* Bulk items do not include any metal objects. Call E.L. Harvey to schedule a special metal goods pickup.
