The purpose of this program is to provide Bellingham Small Businesses, as defined above, an opportunity to request a onetime grant award to be used to help address fixed debt, payroll, accounts payable, lost sales, and other working capital expenses that could have been recognized had COVID-19 pandemic not occurred.

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The grant request shall not exceed \$5	5,000.00 per business. A business shall apply only once.

Applications posted online: June 4, 2020

Deadline to submit application: June 22, 2020

Economic Sub-Committee recommendations to the Select Board: June 30, 2020

Select Board Awards: July, 2020

All grants will be reviewed in the 2020 calendar year on a first-come-first-serve basis. All funding decisions will be at the sole discretion of the Select Board, with recommendation by the Economic Subcommittee. Grants will be distributed until funding is fully depleted.

An initial screening for eligibility will be conducted by the Town's Economic Development Subcommittee.

Proposals will be reviewed for sufficiency and need. The Town may ask the Applicant for clarification of technical proposal and cost aspects of proposals.
