Instructions for Flammable/Combustible Permits

- Email MSDS Sheets in PDF format to FirePrevention@bellinghamma.org
- Supply a content page in the following format:

- The contents page should be one PDF file.
- Following the contents page should be each MSDS sheet starting at number 1. Each MSDS sheet shall be its own PDF file.
- Flammables/Combustibles shall be stored in an approved Cabinet/room only.
- The quantities should be figured to the maximum you would ever have on hand. At no point should you ever go over your limits.
- After emailing the MSDS and content list, bring \$ 35.00 for the fee, and the permit will be processed.
- An inspection of storage will be done prior to the permit being issued.
- Permit is to be renewed on an annual basis and it is the permit holder's responsibility to apply and comply <u>prior</u> to the expiration of permit.
