Smoke Alarm Requirements: MGL Ch. 148 s. 26E, 26F, 527 CMR 1.00			
Smoke Alarm Requirements	Yes	No	
One smoke Alarm located inside every bedroom			
Alarms must be hardwired interconnected with battery backup			
On every habitable level including basements			
On ceiling outside each sleeping area			
On the ceiling at the base of each stairway, not in stairway			
Alarms within 20' of a kitchen or bath must be photoelectric			
At least 1 Alarm for every 1200 sq. ft. per level			
Smoke Alarms over 10 years old MUST be replaced			
Heat Detector in garage	not required		
Carbon Monoxide Alarm Requirements	Yes	No	
On every habitable level of the residence including basements			
Within 10' of sleeping area door			
Combination Alarms may be used must have voice alert (photoelectric/CO may be used anywh			
Ionization Combination Alarms may be used outside of 20' of kitchen or bath			

Combination Alarms may be used must have voice alert (photoelectric/CO may be used anywh	
Ionization Combination Alarms may be used outside of 20' of kitchen or bath	
Alarms may be battery, plug in with battery back up hardwired with battery back up	
Follow the manufacturers instruction for placement	
The usual life span of a Carbon Monoxide Alarm is 5-7 years	
Is the Address clearly mark with 4" or greater numbers?
