- During a Teacher Professional Development Day-Aug 29th, the library will be a 'teacher choice' so that teachers can learn about resources available. *Bernadette will follow up with Carolyn Rafferty about expectations from schools and the partnership expectations going forward.
- Going forward, BPL will be partnering with schools/school resource officer to enforce library rules. A protocol will be put in place for staff to follow if the library rules are not followed.
- ASK program will require children to be registered. Unattended children will not be allowed to stay after the first day they attend without being registered for ASK.
