Important Dates

February 1st – Library begins accepting submissions February 14th, 8 pm – Submission deadline February 17th – Opening reception, 6-8 pm

Entry Requirements

- Entries must be framed or framed and matted.
- Entry size must be between 5x7 inches and 30x30 inches. Smaller or larger submissions will not be accepted.
- Entries must be originals executed by the person submitting the entry.
- Entries should be non-offensive to a general audience of all ages.
- When possible, entries should not display the artist's name or any identifying mark on the front of the entry.
- If you would like your entry to be included in a digital slide show of submissions, please send the entry in a digital format to library@bellinghamlibrary.org with a subject line of "Art & Photography Show Submission". This slide show will be available on the library website after the event. Please include your name and phone number in the email.
- Entries may be included on a list of items offered for sale to interested attendees on the condition that 10% of the purchase price is donated to the Friends of the Bellingham Public Library
 - The entry form will include a space for you to indicate that you are willing to sell your entry as well as a space for the price.
- Please include your name and contact information on the back of the entry.
- Space will be provided in the library for winning submission to be on display for one year.

Categories

Entries will be accepted in the following categories:

Art: People Places Things Children's Art (ages 12 and under)

Photography: People Places Things

Judging and Awards

Submissions will be judged by a blind jury review process. The submissions will be judged based on quality, content and frame. Names of submitters will be hidden from the view of the judges.

There will be a first, second and third place ribbon awarded in each category.

The first-place winner in each category will be eligible to win the "Best in Show".

Opening reception attendees will vote for the "People's Choice." Each attendee will be given one vote to choose their favorite submission.

Entry and fees

Submissions with applications will be accepted at the library between February 1st and 8 pm on February 14th. The suggested donation is \$5 per entry.

Presentation

All submissions must be delivered framed and ready to hang. Framing must meet gallery quality standards. Frames must be undamaged and reinforced with hardware and appropriate hanging wire (D-rings and braided picture hanging wire is acceptable, however, saw tooth hangers are NOT acceptable). If you provide a piece of artwork with no wire, it will be turned away. We ask that the wire be adequately secured. Framed, finished entries must be a minimum of 5x7 inches and a maximum of 30x30 inches. A label must be attached to the back of the image identifying the name of the submitter, with contact information, title of the submission, and category for judging.

Judges:

Darrell Crow is a Bellingham resident that holds a degree in engineering and journalism and is a self-taught artist. As an oil painting artist, he specializes in Tall Ships, Seascapes and Landscapes. He has authored several books on art and over the past 20 years has taught thousands of workshops throughout the world, including locally at the Bellingham Senior Center.

Renee Kurilla is a Bellingham resident and local author and illustrator. She has a BFA in Illustration and a minor in Graphic Design from Lesley University College of Art and Design. Prior to becoming a children's book author and illustrator, she was a Lead Artist at FableVision Studios for 10 years.

Amanda Leeland is a Bellingham native and professional photographer. She has a BFA in Photography from the University of Massachusetts Dartmouth, is co-President of the Whaling City Camera Club, and an award-winning photographer.

Randy LeSage is a Bellingham resident, an artist, working in painting, printmaking and mixed media. He currently teaches Art at the Worcester Art Museum and has taught at Clark University, Framingham State University, Dean College and other institutions. He has a MFA from the School of the Museum of Fine Arts in affiliation with Tufts University and a BA in studio art from Framingham State University.

Ric Allendorf is not only our acoustic guitarist for this event, but he is also an Assistant Professor of Illustration at the Massachusetts College of Art in Boston. Rick will serve as the judge to choose our "Best In Show" from the First Place Winners chosen by the judges listed above.
