A Master Plan is a **NOT**


- a zoning ordinance

The Master Plan will also have an Implementation Plan to provide clear next steps for the City.




HOW DID WE GET HERE

This process along with the past plans will help the town's residents, businesses, and government leaders set a vision for the future that will allow Bellingham remain a place where people want to live, work, and thrive.









Employment of Residents




