Re: Publication of Zoning By-law Amendment

The following amendment to the Zoning Map adopted at the Special Town Meeting of August 25, 1961, having been approved by the Attorney General, is hereby published:

"To amend the Zoning Map adopted on December 2, 1960, by changing from an Agricultural District to an Industrial district the land now or formerly of the W. & O. Realty Company and formerly leased to the Bellingham Textile, Inc., along with certain other adjoining land located on both the northerly and southerly side of Maple Street in the northerly part of Bellingham, and more particularly bounded as follows: westerly by land now or formerly of the New York, New Haven and Hartford Railroad; northerly by Stall Brook; easterly by the easterly bank of the Charles River; and southerly by the northerly boundary of the Industrial District set aside for proposed Route 495 and as shown on the aforesaid Zoning Map."
