amendment to Zoning By-Laws

Gentlemen:

I hereby certify that the following amendment to the Zoning By-Laws of the Town of Bellingham was adopted at the Special Town Meeting held Dec. 3, 1969, under Article 7 of the Warrant:

Voted: That the Town amend the Zoning By-Laws as follows:

- (A) Amend ARTICLE IV Definitions by inserting the following at its proper alphabetic location: Camping, Commercial. Premises used for campers tenting, or temporary overnight facilities of any kind, operated seasonally, where a fee is charged.
- (B) Amend section 2400, use regulation schedule, by inserting a new row immediately below "campers, supervised" to read as follows:

CAMPING COMMERCIAL	A	R	M	B	I

The vote on the above was as follows:

YES 96; NO 2 ABSTAINING 6 TOTAL 104

2/3 of 98 being 66, the motion carried.

I further certify as follows:

- 1) The warrants for the above Special Town Meeting were posted in at least one public place in each precinct of the Town, in accordance with Town By-Laws.
- 2) The warrants were posted at least fourteen days before said meeting in accordance with Town By-Laws. (date of Posting: 11/18/69).
- 3) The required ^{quorum} of 100 was present ~~was present~~ throughout the above Meeting.
- 4) Notice of the hearing on the above amendment to the Zoning By-Laws to be held by the Planning Board was published in the Woonsocket Call, a newspaper of general circulation in the Town of Bellingham on Oct. 23, 1969. (see attached)
- 5) Gerard Daigle, member of the Planning Board made an oral report for the majority of said Board recommending the above amendment be adopted.
- 6) The hearing by the Planning Board was held at their regular meeting held Nov. 6, 1969. Notice of Regular Meetings was posted 10/8/69. (see attached)
