Dear Attorney General:

I hereby certify that the following motions were adopted under Articles 11 and 13 by voters of the Town of Bellingham at the Special Town Meeting of January 25, 1978:

ARTICLE 11. ZONING BY-LAW AMENDMENT

VOTED: It was unanimously voted that the Town delete Section 4421 of the Bellingham Zoning By-Law in its entirety, substituting the following:

"4421. Not more than 10% of the cumulative number of dwelling units on the premises having been granted occupancy permits at any point in time may have three (3) bedrooms and none may have more than that number, unless the Special Permit originally allowing the development explicitly authorizes occupancy permits for more or larger units. Said authorization shall be granted only where:

- a) Lot area will equal at least 10,000 square feet per bedroom;
- b) Full compliance has been met as per Sec. 1321 of these by-laws;

ARTICLE 13. BY-LAW AMENDMENT


VOTED: That the Town amend Section 2-68 of the Bellingham Code of By-Laws so that the same may read as follows:

"Each officer, board or committee authorized to spend money shall, on or before July tenth of each year, transmit to the Town Accountant all unpaid bills outstanding as of June 30th of that same year."


