> Special Town Meeting VOTE, Zoning By-law Changes

Dear Attorney General:

I hereby certify that the following motions were adopted by the qualified voters of the Town of Bellingham under Articles 7, 8, and 17 of the Warrant for the Special Town Meeting of November 15, 1984:

ARTICLE 7. AMEND SECTION 4600 ZONING BY-LAWS - EARTH REMOVAL REFINEMENTS

VOTED: Unanimously voted that the Town amend Section 4600 of the Bellingham Zoning By-law as follows;

1. Amend Section 4632 by adding the following at the end thereof: "Such bond shall have an expiration date not less than six months later than the permit termination date."

2. Amend Section 4670 by revising the first sentence by adding a

final clause so that it reads as follows:

"No permit shall be issued under the provisions of Section 4600 for a period of more than two years, but a permit may be renewed upon application without a public hearing provided that such renewal is approved prior to expiration of the permit being renewed." (underlining only to indicate added clause).

#### ARTICLE 8. ZONING MAP REVISIONS .

VOTED: Unanimously voted that the Town amend the Bellingham Zoning By-law by revising the map as follows:

- A. Extend the Suburban District westward to the Mendon town line generally between Hartford Avenue and Box Fond, as shown at "A" on the map titled "PROPOSED DISTRICT REFINEMENTS", dated 8-24-84.
- B. Extend the Suburban District eastward to the Peters River between Cross Street and the abandoned railroad right-of-way, as shown at "B" on the above-referenced map.
- C. Extend the Suburban District eastward to the Peters River between Pulaski Boulevard and Pine Grove Avenue and extend the Residential District northward to the Peters River and a line 1,000 feet north of the northern sideline of Wrentham Street, both as shown at "C" on the above-referenced map.
- D. Extend the Residential District southward to Bungay Brook south of Wrentham Street, as shown at "D" on the above-referenced map.
- E. Extend the Suburban District northward to the railroad right of way north of Mechanic Street, as shown at "E" on the above-referenced map.
- F. Extend the Business-2 District east of South Main Street eastward to Arnold's Brook, as shown at "F" on the above-referenced map.

### ARTICLE 17. ZONING CHANGE - SOUTH MAIN STREET

VOTED: That the Town re-zone the hereinafter described three (3) parcels of land from Residential Districts to Business B-2, so as to effectively extend the B-2 District which is located on the Southwesterly side of South Main Street to include said parcels which are located on the Southwesterly side of the intersection of South Main Street and Blackstone Street, with a frontage on said South Main Street of four hundred twenty-three and 15/100 (423.15) feet more or less and said area contains three and 58/100 (3.58) acres more or less, more accurately described on Bellingham Assessor's Map 59 as parcels numbered six (6), seven (7), and eight (8), a copy of said Bellingham Assessor's Map filed with the Board of Selectmen and made available for more particular description, and incorporated herein by reference and made a part hereof.

VOTEr By hand count - YES 129; NO 1; Total 130. -2/3 of 130 being 87, the motion carried.




